

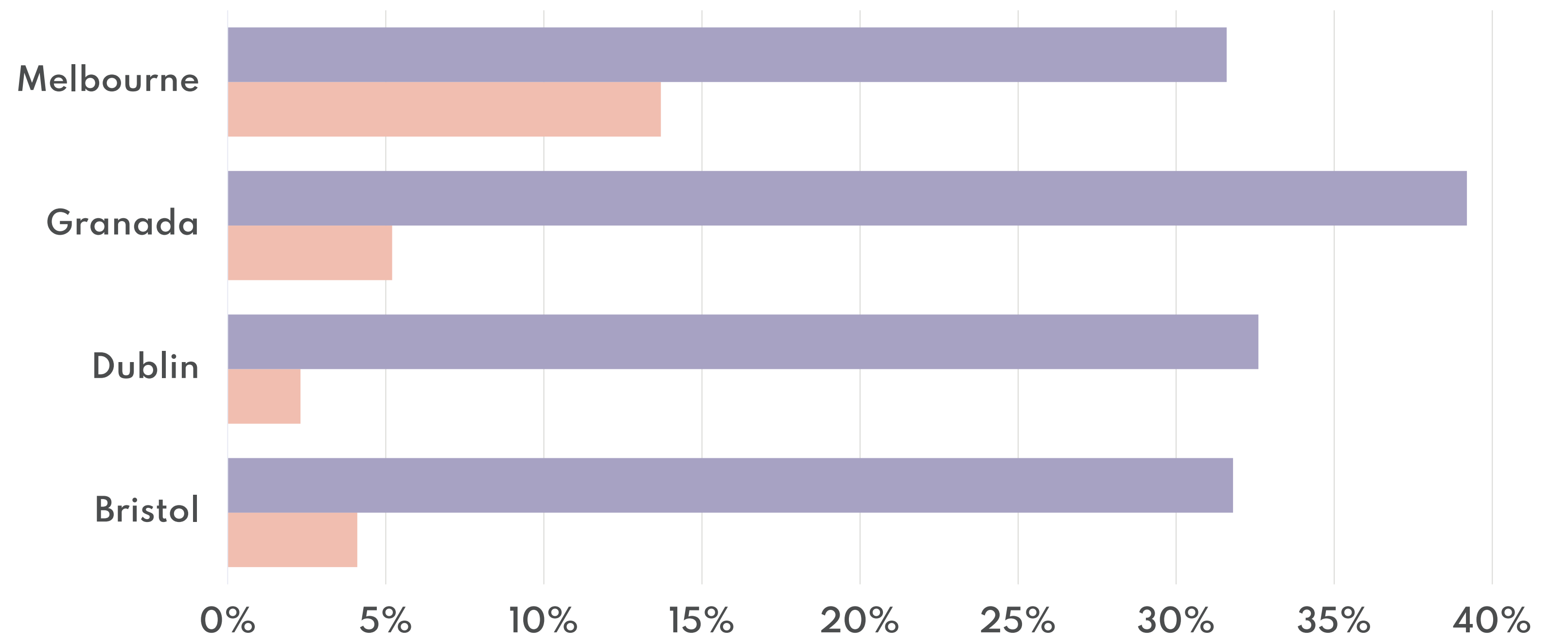


Women's Average Age in Pregnancy

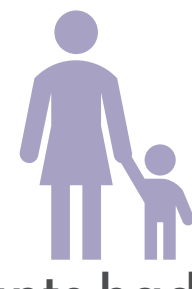

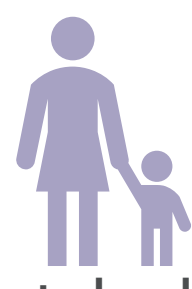

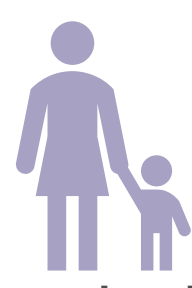

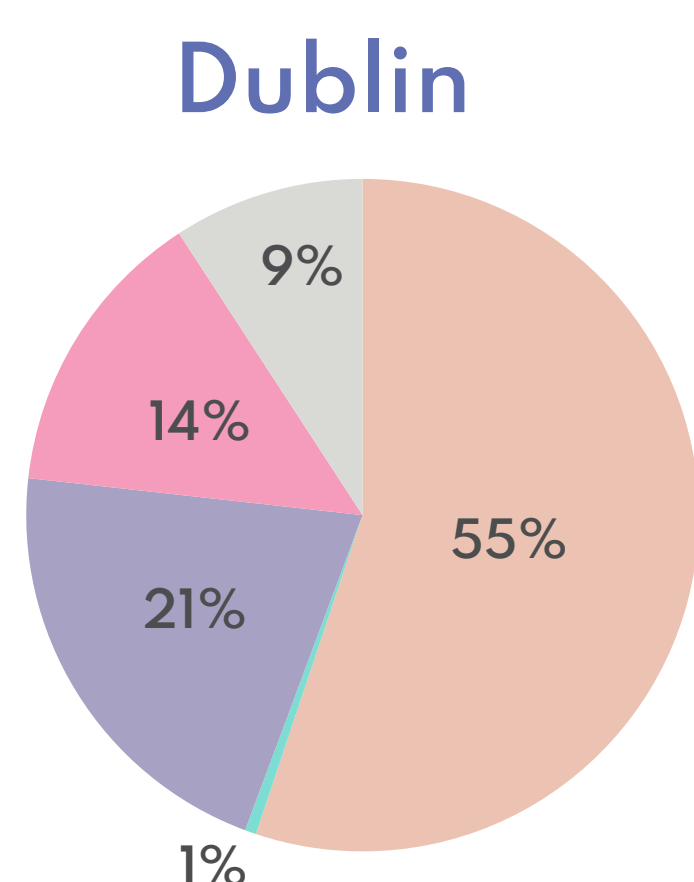

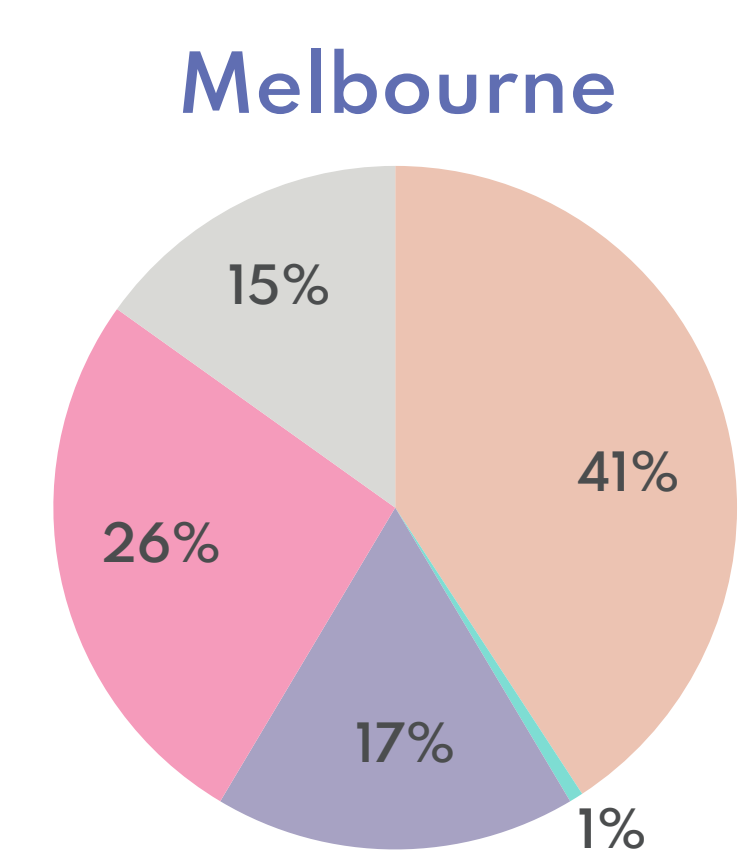
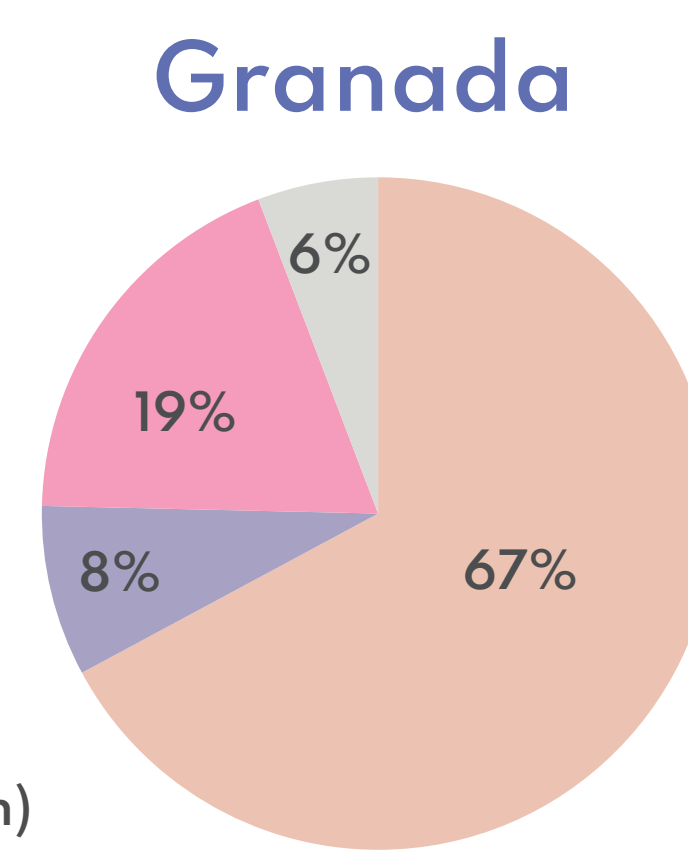

Type of birth



- Normal vaginal birth
- Breech birth
- Planned caesarean section
- Unplanned caesarean section
- Assisted vaginal birth (forceps and vacuum)



All sites had at least 50% of women deliver vaginally (assisted and unassisted)

Granada had the highest number of vaginal births and Melbourne had the highest assisted vaginal births

Women in Bristol had the shortest stay in hospital

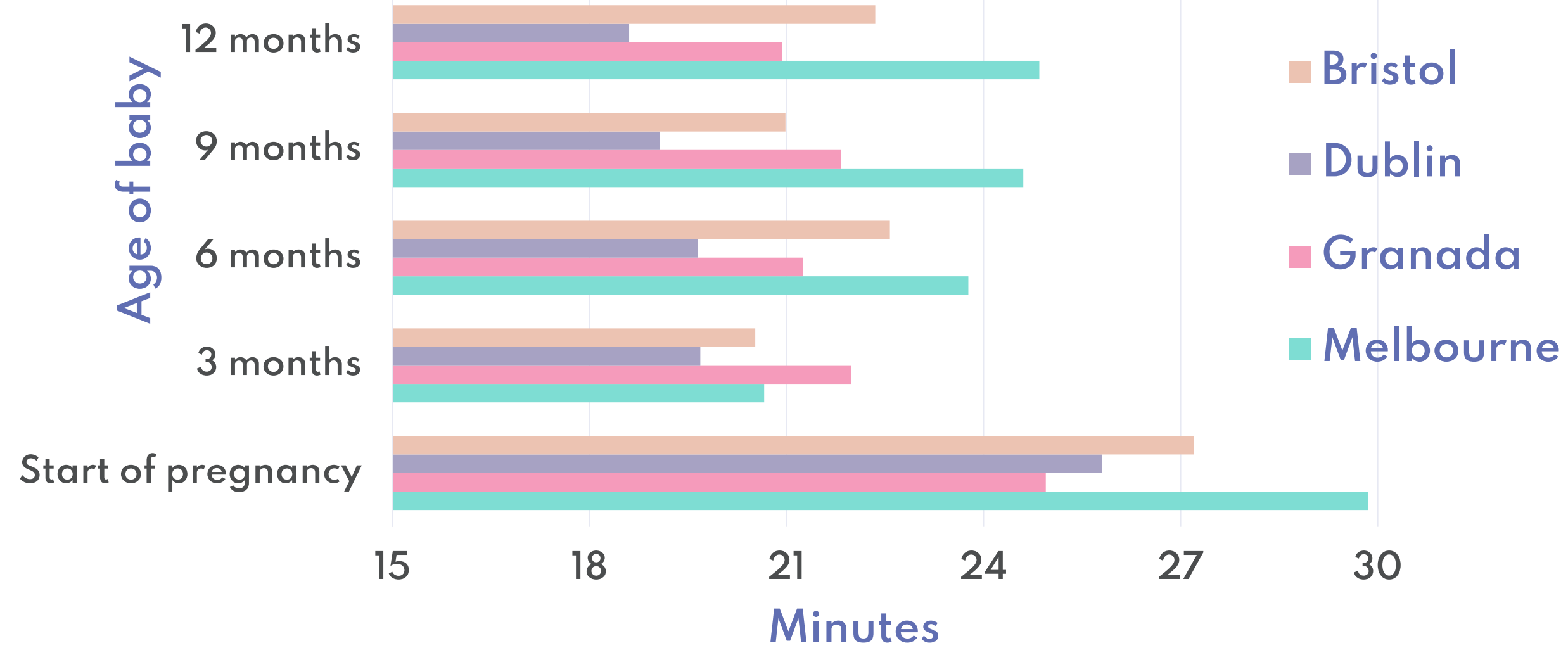
Women in Granada had the longest stay in hospital



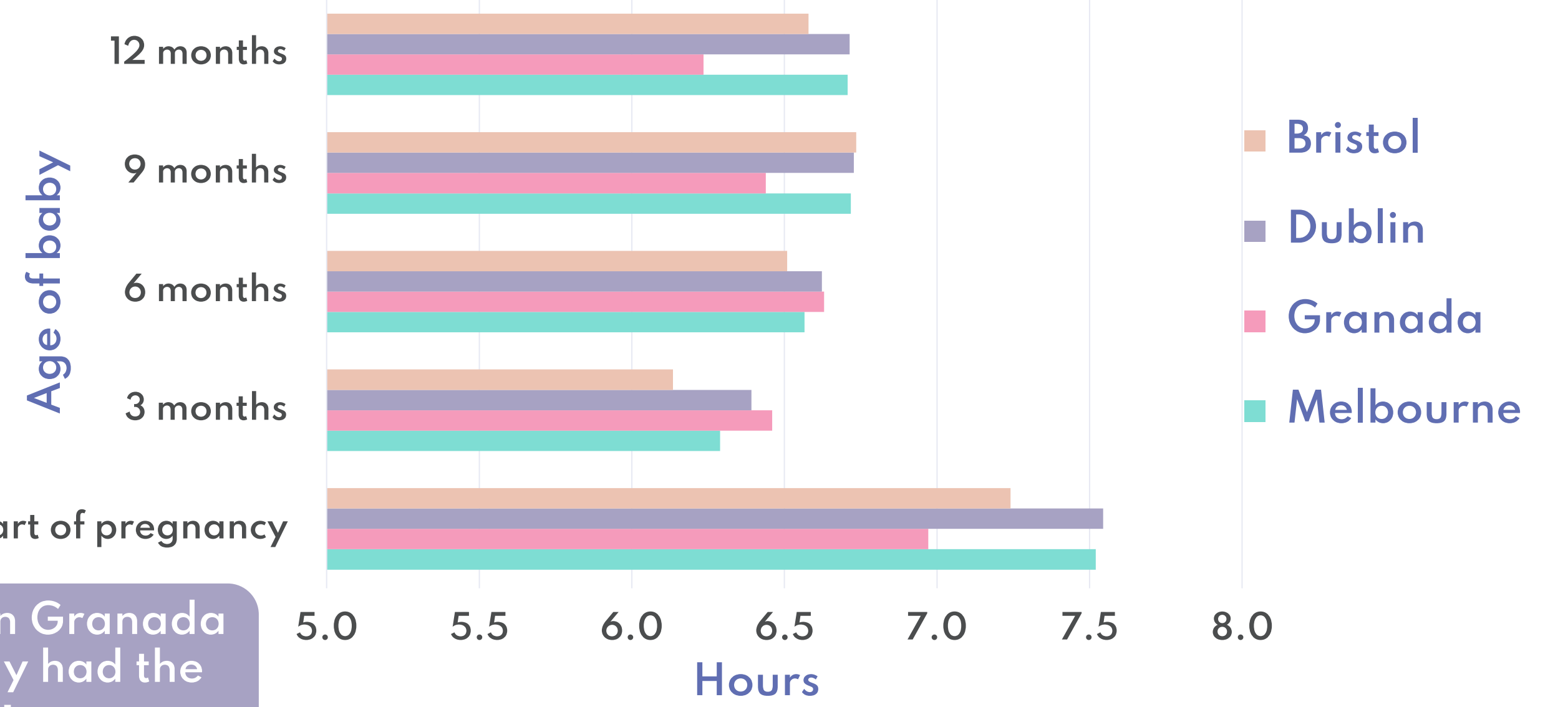


Women in Dublin fell asleep the quickest

Average number of minutes taken by women to fall asleep



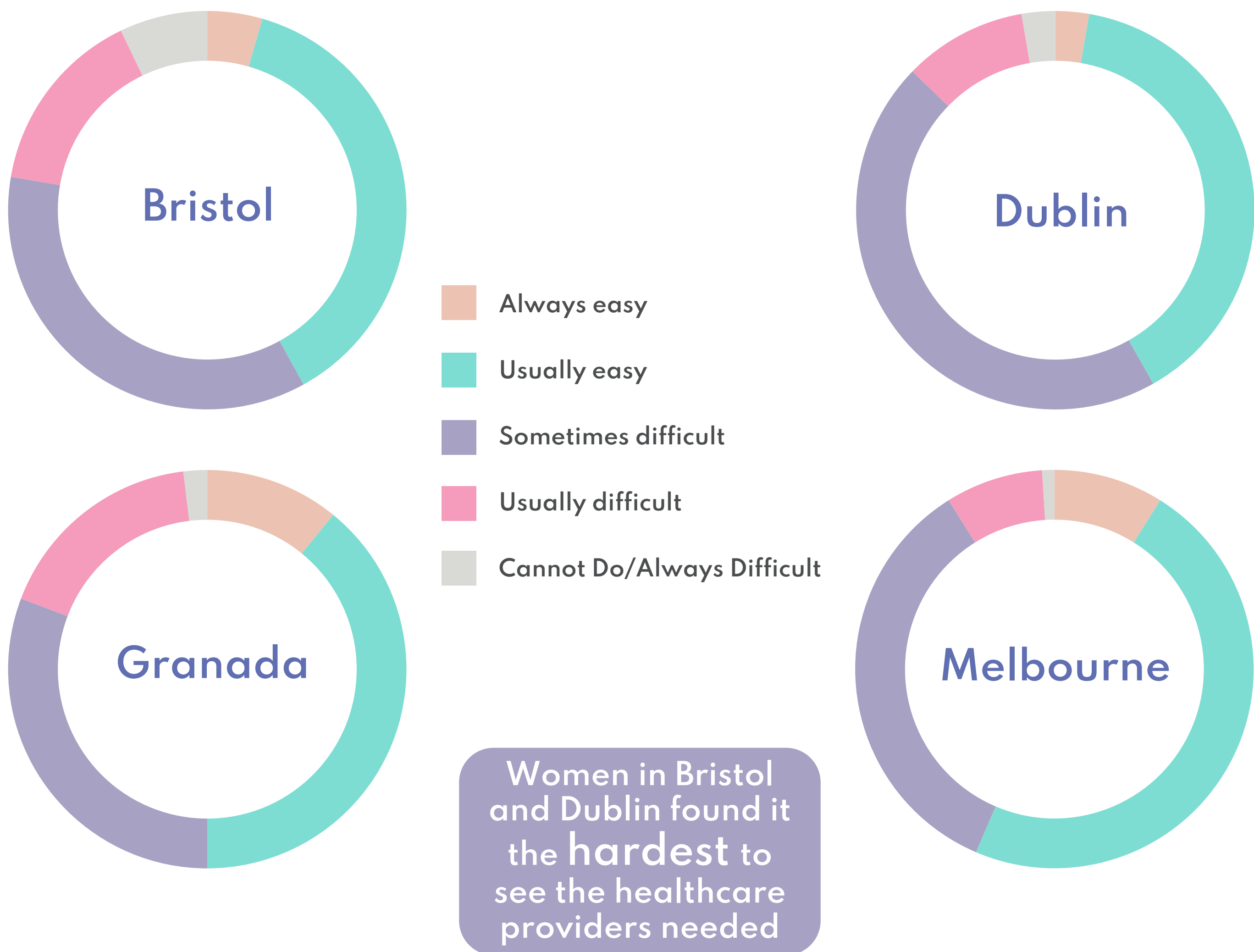
Womens' average hours of sleep



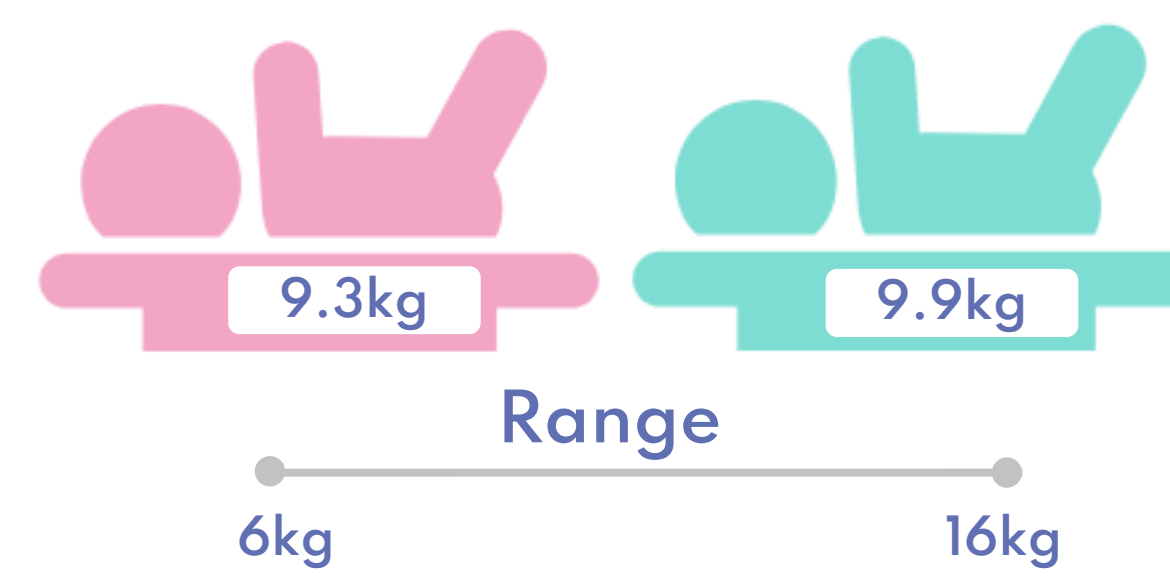
Women in Granada generally had the least sleep



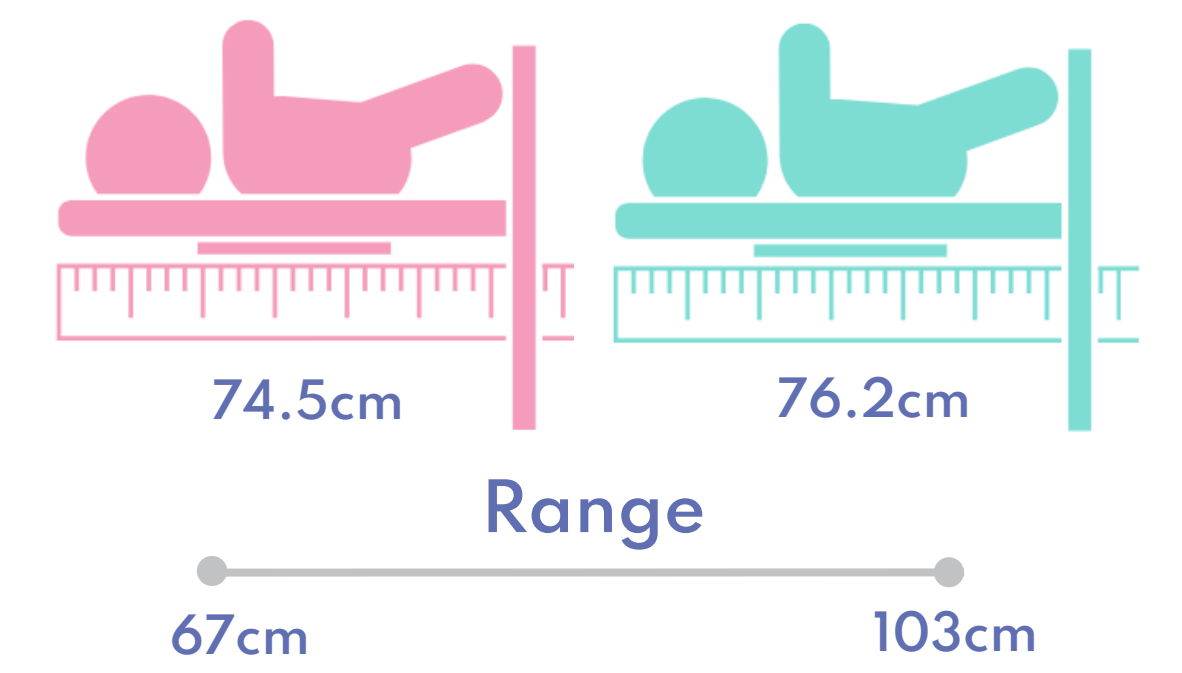

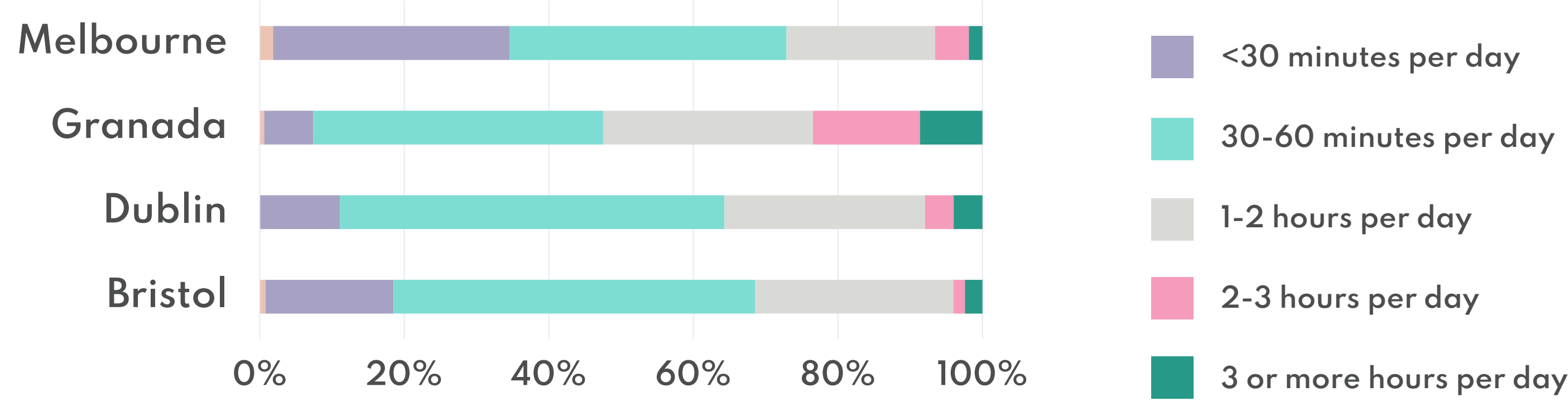

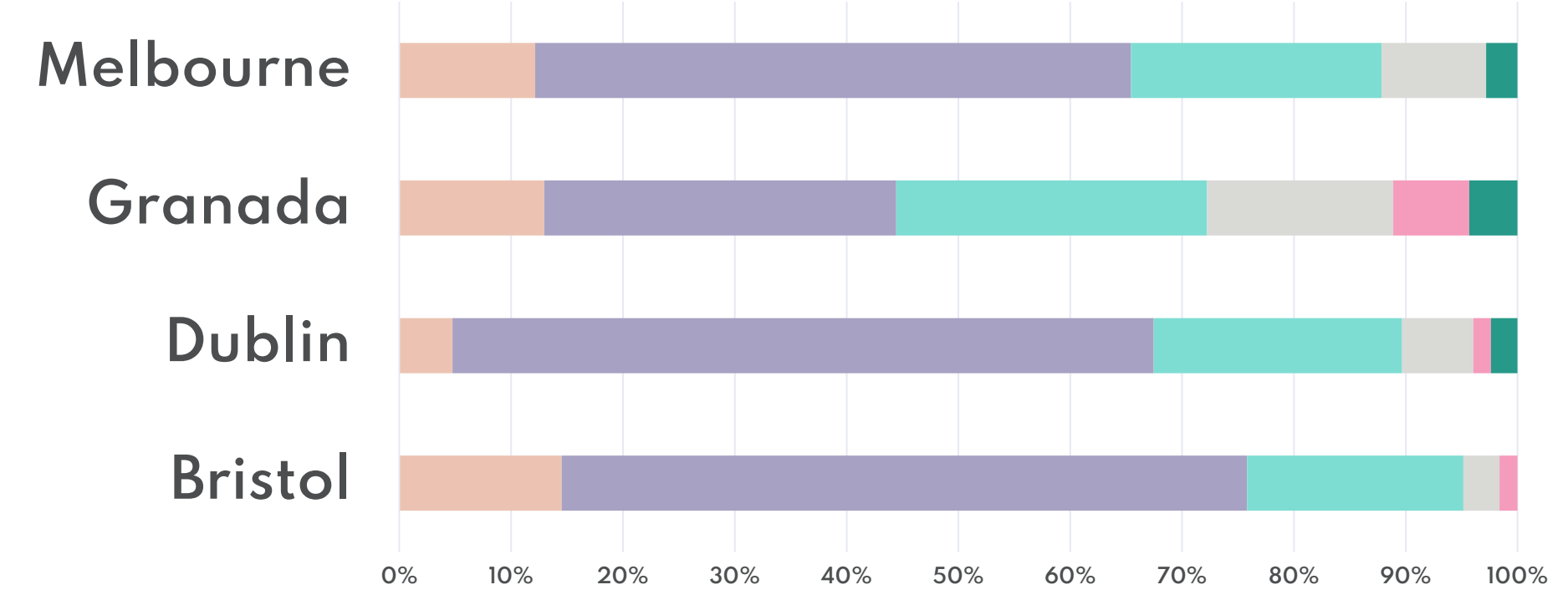
Amount of light cleaning (making beds, laundry, ironing, putting things away) with 12-month-old baby



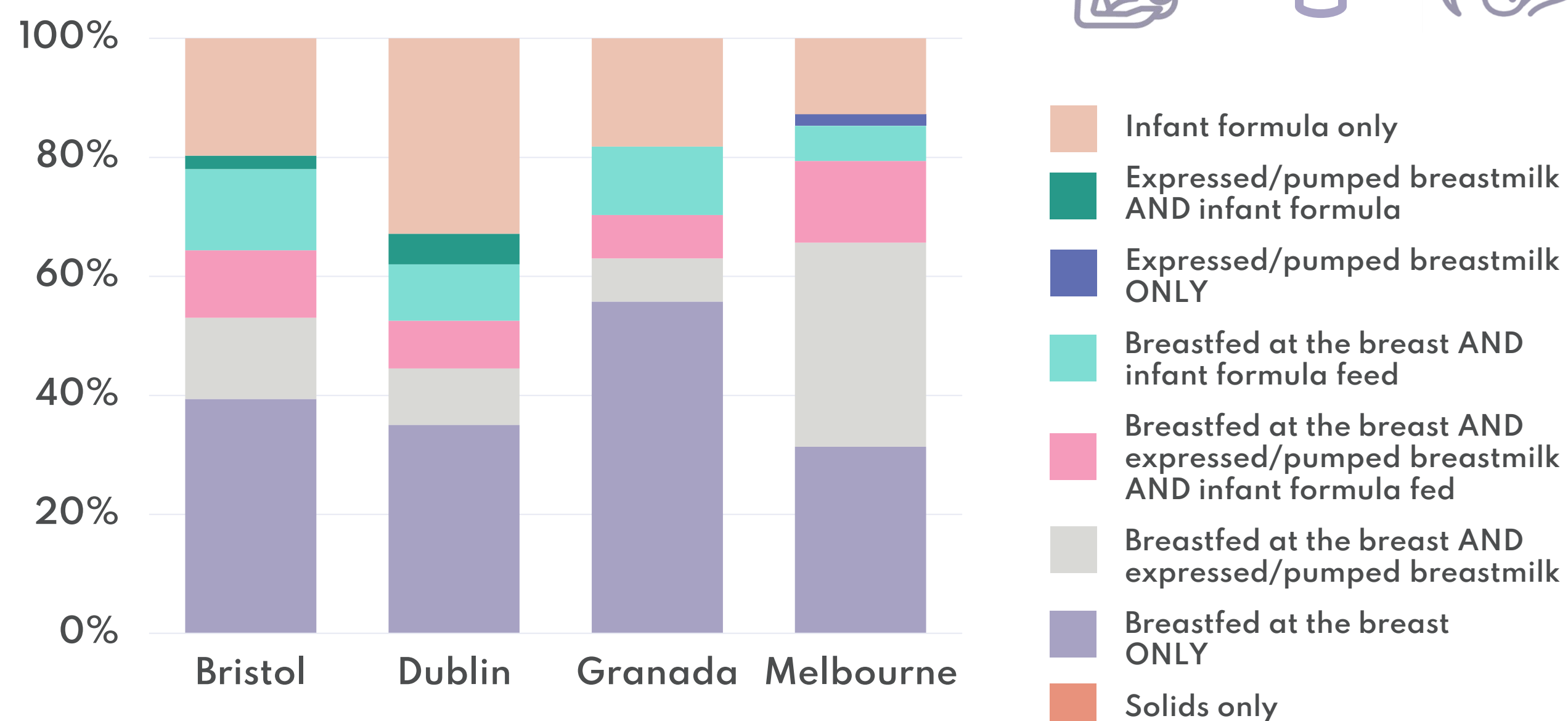
Women in Granada spent the most time cleaning



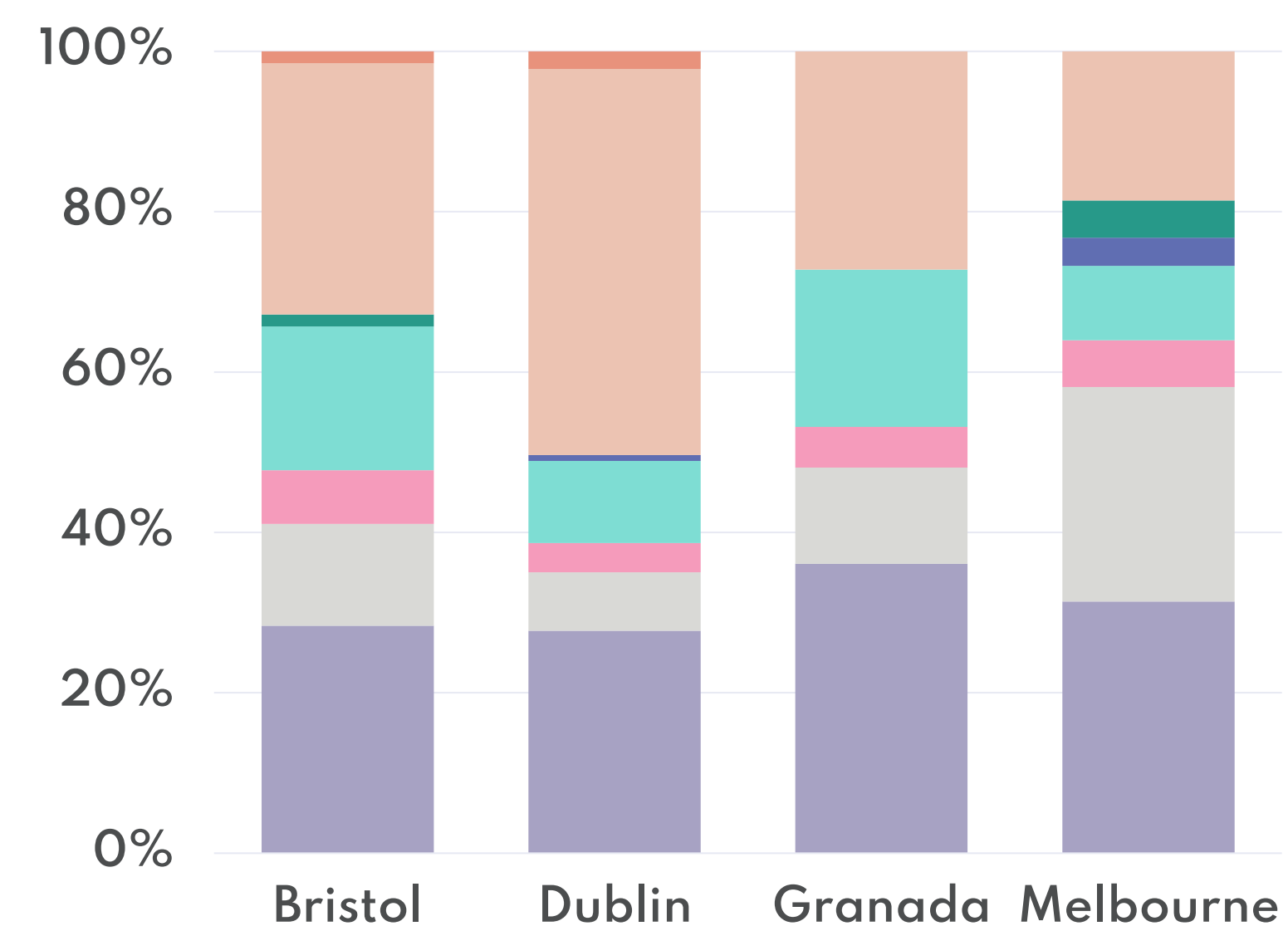
Amount of heavier cleaning (vacuuming, mopping, sweeping, washing windows) with 12-month-old baby
